Report of research visit March 14-18, 2016 Liisi Laineste Krakow and Lodz

The first visit of the cooperation project "Communication styles: Developing a cross-cultural theoretical and methodological framework" was held on March 14-18, during which Dr Liisi Laineste met with the Polish cooperation partners Drs Dorota Brzozowska and Władysław Chłopicki, and Anna Rewis Łętkowska.
