

RULES

FOR THE ORGANIZATION OF THE BELIEF NARRATIVE NETWORK (BNN)

(adopted by the BNN members on June 25, 2009 at the 15th congress of
the ISFNR in Athens)

- (1) Status: The Belief Narrative Network (BNN) is a voluntary association and forms part of the ISFNR.
- (2) Membership is open and free to members of the ISFNR.
- (3) Members of the BNN are working on belief narrative. Members have to register with the BNN committee in order to participate in network activities.
- (4) Any member can raise an issue for discussion. Discussions will take place at conferences, via email list and through Internet mediated sites.
- (5) The members are the primary decision makers. Decisions will be made by ballot. Decisions will be made by a simple majority of votes.
- (6) Organization: Members are called to volunteer for duty on the committee.
- (7) Network members will elect from among the volunteers a Committee of at least five members to carry out the day-to-day work. Among these committee members will be a chairperson who keeps the membership records and oversees the Committee's work.
- (8) Committee members are elected for a term of four years. Existing members may put themselves forward for re-elections.
- (9) Reports: Every year the chairperson on behalf of the committee submits a report on previous year's activities to the members of the BNN. These reports will also be conveyed to the executive committee of the ISFNR.
